## Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025 Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Long Stratton (STRO12096) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to Norfolk County Council urgent carriageway repairs to prevent further damage the use by vehicles (of any class) of the U76130 Stratton Lane from its junction with U76129 Edges Lane to its junction with U76026 Church (the "Road") in the Town of Long Stratton will be temporarily prohibited.

The closure/restriction is necessary or expedient because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2025 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 19<sup>th</sup> January 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall be in effect from 15<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until the closure/restriction no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 19<sup>th</sup> January 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by an Order.

Alternative route is via: Edges Lane, Norwich Road, Church Lane (Morningthorpe and Fritton, Long Stratton).

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.


