

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (STRO10737) affecting the U76180 Parkers Lane from its junction with A140 Ipswich Road for 1200m eastwards in the PARISH OF LONG STRATTON to facilitate new road construction works in Norfolk County Council.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 4th May 2024 to 3rd November 2025 for the duration of the works expected to be about 549 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: U76180 Parkers Lane C355 Hall Lane C355 Mill Road C356 The Green, Ansons Lane U76042 Wood Lane U76019 Wood Lane A140 Ipswich Road U76180 Parkers Lane (Pulham Market, Wacton, Morningthorpe and Fritton, Long Stratton, Shelton and Hardwick)

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

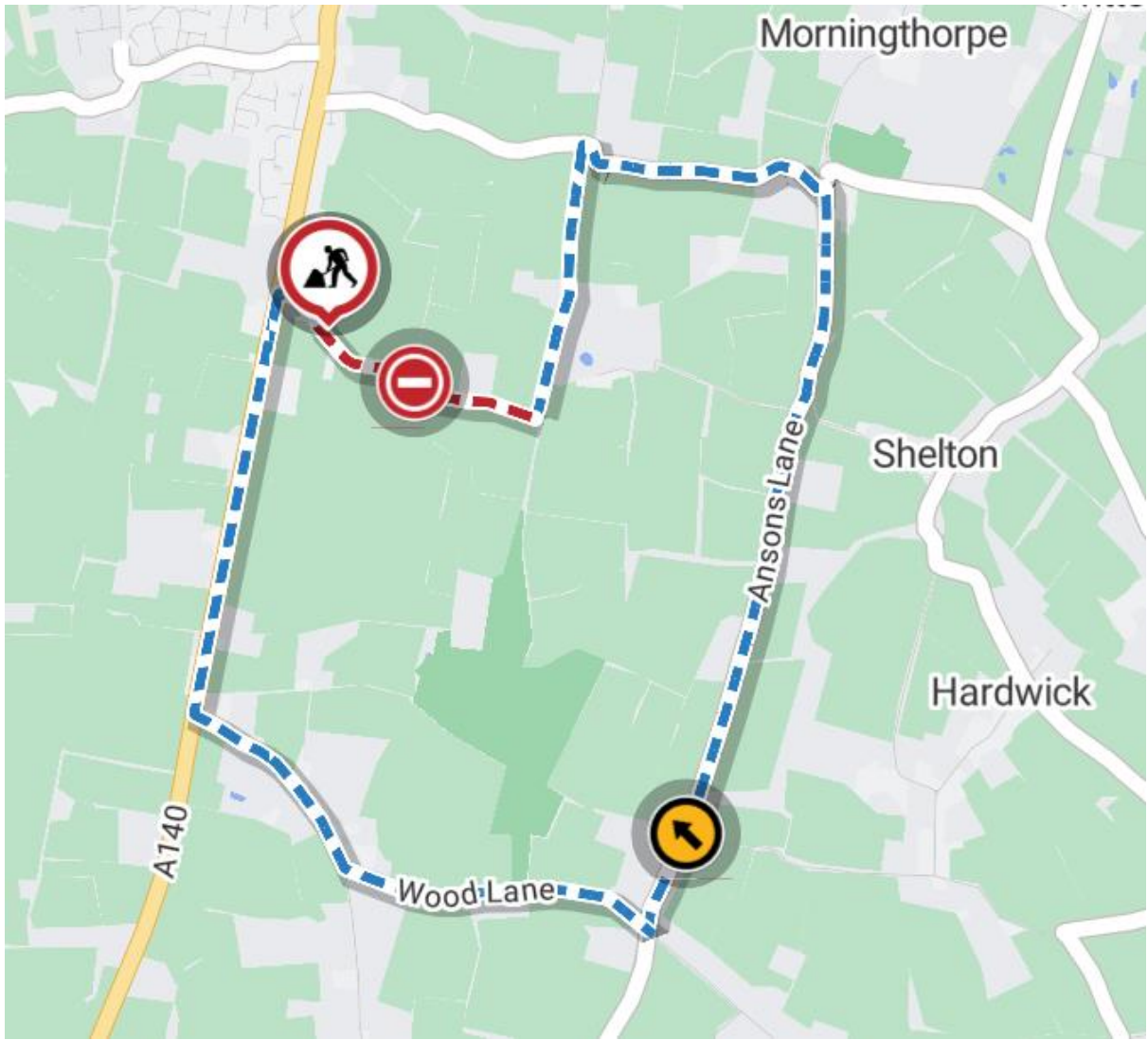
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
