## Norfolk County Council (Wacton) Emergency Notice Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025

## Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025 Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Wacton (STRO12160) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to Anglian Water manhole chamber replacement works the use by vehicles (of any class) of the U76030 Hall Lane from its junction with U76170 Wash Lane for 30m southwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Wacton will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: Hall Lane, Market Lane, Frosts Lane, Frith Way, High Green, Woodrow Lane, Station Road, Moulton Road, B1134 Station Road, A140 Ipswich Road, Flowerpot Lane, Stratton Road (Pulham Market, Great Moulton, Tivetshall, Wacton, Long Stratton, Tharston and Hapton, Aslacton).

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 27<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2025 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 16<sup>th</sup> February 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 16<sup>th</sup> February 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
