Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Starston (STRO12518) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to inoperable stop tap the use by vehicles (of any class) of the C877 The Street from 180m west of its junction with C201 Church Hill for 50m westwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Starston will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: C877 The Street, C201 Church Hill / Hardwick Road / Starston Road / C201 Port Road / Common Road / Low Road / Middle Road / The Street / B1527 Hempnall Road, A140 Norwich Road / The Street / Ipswich Road, C877 Tivetshall Road / Tattlepot Road / Bank Street / The Green / Harleston Road / Norwich Road / The Street / Harleston Road / Pulham Road (Pulham Market, Morningthorpe and Fritton, Shelton and Hardwick, Tivetshall, Pulham St. Mary, Starston, Long Stratton).

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 20th to 26th March 2025 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 9th April 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 9th April 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Anglian Water.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

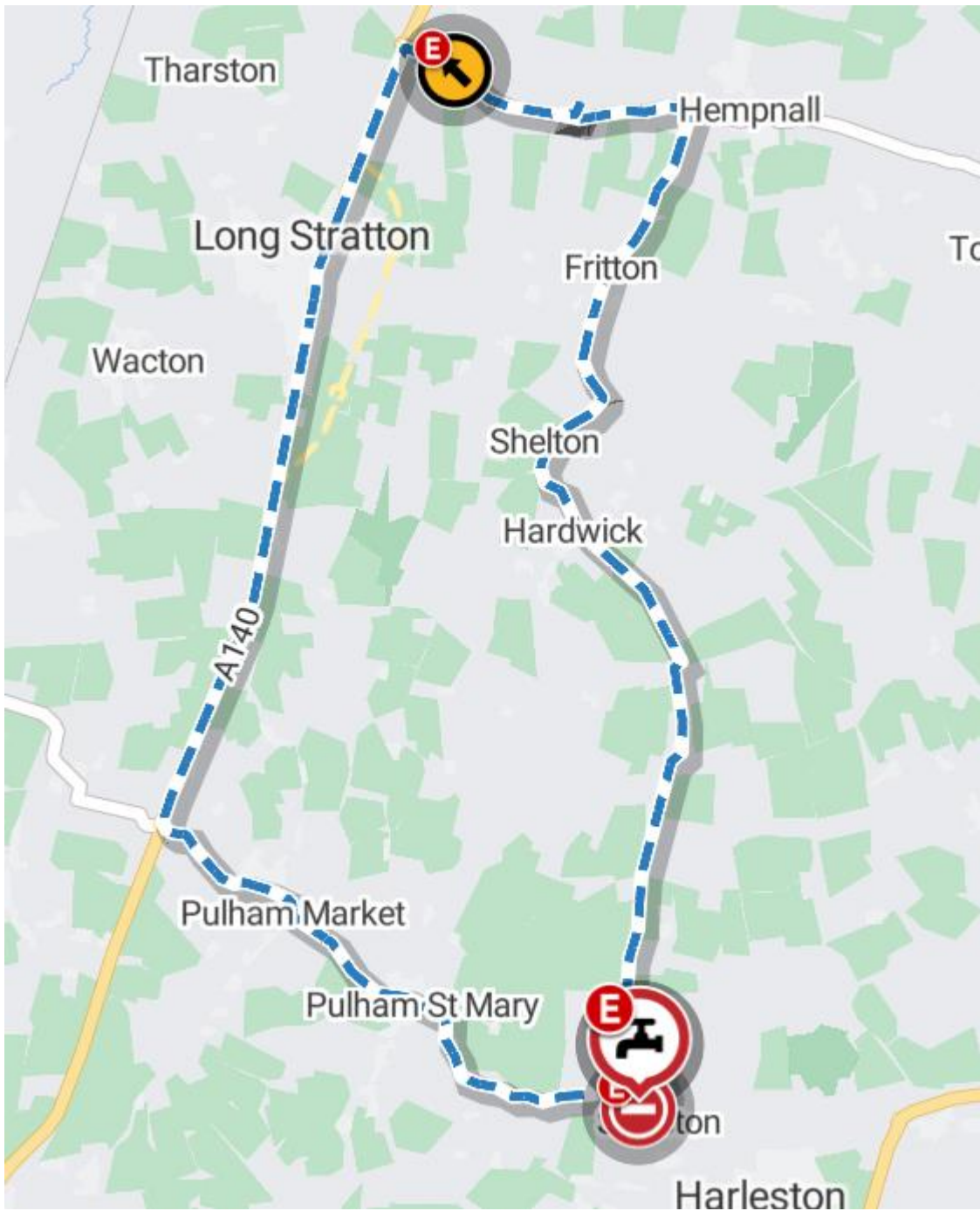
