Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (STRO12311) affecting the B1332 Norwich Road from its junction with B1527 Church Road for 1180m northwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Woodton to facilitate Norfolk County Council carriageway resurfacing works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 20:00 and 05:00 from 24<sup>th</sup> March to 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 13<sup>th</sup> May 2025 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: B1332 Norwich Road, B1527 Church Road, Short New Road, Hempnall Road, Bungay Road, Mill Road, A140 Ipswich Road, A47 Trunk Road A146 Loddon Road B1332 Norwich Road (Poringland, Swainsthorpe, Kirstead, Framingham Earl, Trowse with Newton, Brooke, Morningthorpe and Fritton, Topcroft, Keswick and Intwood, Stoke Holy Cross, Woodton, Hempnall, Tasburgh, Saxlingham Nethergate, Long Stratton, Caistor St. Edmund and Bixley, Newton Flotman).

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 13<sup>th</sup> May 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
